#### Remembrance of a Veteran

Veterans Day Observance 2019. I share with you a veteran of the 29th Division from Carroll County, who served during WWII. **Captain John W. Fringer, Sr. who joined the Maryland National Guard on August 18, 1930.** He earned the rank of Sergeant with the 1st Infantry of the Guard which was subsequently, re-designated the 115th Infantry Regiment, 29th Division. Sgt. Fringer was activated 1 February, 1941 and promoted to 1LT on 1 February, 1942 and then promoted to Captain on 13 August, 1943. Captain Fringer, died on 5 March, 1945 as a result of wounds received in combat during WWII. Capt. Fringer is buried in the American cemetery in Luxembourg.

His son, Lt. Colonel John (Jack) W. Fringer, Jr. a retired veteran of the US Army and his family, annually visits the Westminster Cemetery on Memorial Day where his mother Belle Fringer, a first-grade teacher at the old East End Elementary School on Center street and buried at the cemetery. Col. Fringer and his family pays tribute to his parents during the Memorial Day ceremonies.

Veteran Day 2019, a time to remember and reflect on all of those who have served their country. A salute to Captain Fringer for his distinguished service to his country.

Unfortunately, since we vacated the National Guard Armory a couple years ago, our crab feeds are no longer what they used to be. I'm not sure if it's the out of Frederick location, or something else that has turned people off. The prices have remained the same (for the present time) so it's not that. I don't think you will find a feed anywhere else that offers what we do for the prices we ask. The crabs have been running a good size for the past two years, and the remainder of the food is of the same or even better quality. So there's something there that we're just not seeing. We ended up with about 75 people at the feed on October 5th. And that date may have played a role in the lower attendance. We had some confusion

over the date, but I felt we had that resolved in time that it did not cause any serious problems.

Our next and final project of the year will be the Christmas With the Vets Program. We are tentatively planning on 150-160 veterans in the eight nursing homes we service in Frederick.
