Pikesville Armory Update

Things are going forward very quickly for the Pikesville Armory and its future.

We (the Joint Committee of the Veterans of the Pikesville Military Reservation, of which Larkspur Post 110 is a member along with the 121st Engineers, the Maryland Military Historical Society Roundtable, the NCO Club itself, and the Warrant Officers Association) are one of the members of the Pikesville Armory Foundation (PAF), a 501 (c) non-profit organization. PNC Ginsburg is the Vice President of the PAF that felt strongly the veterans needed a seat on the Board.

The PAF has been in discussions with the Baltimore County Executive, Governor Hogan and other key decision makers to transform the Reservation and ensure the veterans (and the community) have a place to continue to meet at the NCO Club. \$500K has been put into Governor Hogan's budget (not passed yet) and another \$500K has been put into a bond issue sponsored by State Senator Hettleman (a key ally of the PAF) and our local Delegates.

A key part of this is that the veterans will need to pick up the utilities for the NCO Club and day to day expenses if things break down. That means we need to build up a war chest of at least \$20K in the next few months to have that ready when the bills start rolling in, which will probably be in the late spring as the Maryland Military Department vacates the Reservation and hands it to the State.

The Foundation will be able to collect the donations and it will be 100% tax deductible to all who contribute. The donations should be earmarked for the use of the NCO Club so that the Foundation can only spend it for that purpose.

The bank account should be ready in a couple of weeks so please hold off on the donations until then. PNC Ginsburg will let everyone know when they can contribute.

A lot of people associated with the groups that meet at the NCO Club committed money last fall. Therefore, it is essential we follow up and come through with what everyone can afford if we want to have a continued presence at the NCO Club for the years to come. It is critical that when everyone stood by the veterans to make sure we kept the NCO Club, we stand up and do our part with the fund raising.

Please note, this is just the first step. We will be having capital campaigns (along with the resources of the Foundation) to fund roof replacement, the possible reestablishment of the Museum in the back of the NCO Club, and the placing of some historical markers on the Reservation to honor the soldiers and units that served there.
