New England Post 93, Northeast & Worldwide At-Large Region Commander: Fran Sherr-Davino

We belatedly became aware of the death of Post 93 WWII veteran John Guadino. John was awarded both the Silver Star and Bronze Star for his service with the 111th Field Artillery Battalion.

John's valor as a radio operator in a 111th observation team is chronicled in 29th Division Historian Joseph Balkoski's book Our Tortured Souls: The 29th Infantry Division in the Rhineland.

In the November 1944 battle, chronicled in news coverage as "The Lost Company of Koslar," his unit survived a two-day siege against long odds.

"Drinking rain water and treating their wounds with blood plasma dropped to them from Cub planes, (they) held out heroically against superior German forces until another battalion fought its way to Koslar and rescued them," the Associated Press reported.

Guadino was among four members of the "Lost Company" to receive Silver Stars. Balkoski writes that the Germans were so close that the combatants could see each other from basement windows in a building surrounding a courtyard.

After the war, John owned the H & B Tool and Engineering Company of Connecticut.

This month, we welcome another Legacy member. Tom Claassen, of Pennsylvania, joined to honor the 29th Division service of his father.
