Patch Fight!

The fight to save the 29th Division patch continues. The Naming Commission's initial release of recommended changes to base names has met, in their mind, unforeseen opposition. As a result, I have just learned that in a recent letter to SecDef Lloyd Austin, **they have agreed to allow the patch to remain**, while recommending modifications to be considered by Army Heraldry. There will be more details available in the upcoming Summer *Twenty-Niner*.

The Commission's final report is on schedule to be delivered to Congress NLT 1 October. We have provided key members of Congress requesting their support, along with a copy of the outstanding video the Association produced and remains available on our website, <https://29thdivisionassociation.com>

Our "Save the Patch" petition is also available there. Please share it and our efforts with former members and friends you may know.

In addition, please consider a donation to our 29th Division Association, through the "29 Let's Go" Support Fund Foundation. We have received support from 112 donors, but that amounts to less than 5% of our 2,300-plus membership. By eliminating National dues, your Association had hoped to build a significant "war chest" to reflect opposition to the Naming Commission's threat to our patch. We're down to just over 90 days before they present their findings to Congress.

Your gift, in any amount, will help us continue to save the patch and support our efforts to tell the story of the 29th Division. Our efforts in this area include our recently completed plaque at the National Museum of the United States Army on Ft. Belvoir, a statue in France to honor our WWI heroes, and revitalizing some of our existing monuments here and abroad.

For the younger members (under 80 years old) of Limestone Post 1-72, I'd like to give you a brief history of your post.

In January of 1919, while the 29th Division was headquartered at Borbonne-les-Bains, France, the commander of the 29th Division, MG Charles G. Morton, initiated efforts to have a divisional veterans association similar to the veteran organizations formed after the Civil War. The association would consist of all regiments and units of the division and have annual reunions.

Since the division was made up largely of Marylanders, the first chartered post of the association was Baltimore Post 1, 29th Division Association.

On November 14, 1945, Limestone Post 72 was chartered and composed mainly of World War-II veterans of the 175th Regiment who were formerly in Post 1 or new to the Association. "Limestone" was

the code name of the regiment during the war. Many years later and due to the lack of active members in Post 1, a motion was passed to merge Post 1 and Post 72 together and Limestone Post 1-72 was formed in 2016.

World War II 29th Division veteran, Steve Melnikoff, returned to Normandy once again for the 78th Anniversary of D-Day. While in England, he was interviewed on British television. Steve reported that the 29th Division monument at Hill 108 has been cleaned and is in excellent shape.


