As always, the gathering will provide an opportunity for old friends to reconnect, welcome new members, and continue strengthening the ties that bind together generations of Soldiers who served under the Blue and Gray patch. By the end of D-Day, the division had established positions inland despite the tremendous cost. The actions of the 29th Division on Omaha Beach helped secure the Allied foothold in Normandy and paved the way for the liberation of France and Western Europe.

The courage and sacrifice displayed by those Soldiers on D-Day remain an enduring example of duty, perseverance, and service before self. Their legacy lives on through the veterans, families, and supporters who continue to gather under the banner of the 29th Division Association.

We look forward to seeing everyone at Portside on 8 June.
